In Focus - BCUC



The Buckingham Chilterns University College is currently involved in a large redevelopment project. Jot Design were given the opportunity to work on 2 floor the project of



redeveloping the workspaces for the college's admin staff and lecturers. The reception and admin areas became the setting for several Jot white benching systems as well as a range of Jot laterals and tambour units. Working closely with Bramwells we also designed, built and installed a reception desk area and a pigeon hole system where students could hand in essays and course work.



The different floors as you can see above were colour coded, the lower floor desking had maple finishes and Baby Blue screens where as the desking upstairs was White with Red screens. Each room was identical in layout and provided room for 7 teaching staff. Specially designed shelving was manufactured by Jot to allow for books to be stored at the end of the benches. 2 drawer Jot laterals were also installed as well as extra bookcases in an alcove that each room had.

The project was completed successfully and we are now keen to work with BCUC on other areas of their redevelopment.
